Media

- ⑩ Newspapers: contact your local paper to produce a Sunday insert "Meet your Local Women in Business" Supply photos and bios of Chapter members and seek out women in the community to highlight their achievements in Print.
- ⑩ Radio: Create a 60 second PSA announcing the observance of NYS Women in Business Week October 16-22nd. & giving a brief mission/vision of NYS Women Inc. statement.
- ⑩ Invite a local female TV personality to your October meeting to share her success story in the media. Usually television stations send a camera man to film personal appearances, which provides an great opportunity to announce NYS Women in Business Week.

Partnering:

- ⑩ Connect with local businesses (banking, insurance, auto sales) to sponsor a luncheon honoring women with a "Woman of Achievement" award.
- ⑩ Meet with government leaders to announce the week's observance, and issue a proclamation.
- ⑩ Contact other women's groups such a NAWBO (National Association of Women Business Owners) to honor women entrepreneurs.
