- d) Write and send information to the Communicator, Nike, Board and Annual Conference Books.
- e) Serve as a State Representative when current Executive Committee Members and Chairs are unavailable to attend Region Meetings
- f) <u>Serve as a voting member of the Board of Directors</u>. Familiarize yourself with the duties of the Board of Directors
- g) Be a resource to any officer, board member, or committees needing assistance.
- h) Help with chapter, regional and state installation ceremonies.
- i) Be available to assist with Conference Calls or necessary planning.
- j) Encourage women to help other women become better Professionally, Personally, Politically.
- k) Encourage all members of New York State Women, Inc. to develop programs, activities, and interactions with young females, high school, college and 20, 30 year olds as part of their challenge.
- I) Be visible celebrating accomplishments of New York State Women, Inc.
- m) Participate in Women's Equality Day and New York State Women's Day at the New York State Fair
- n) Accept History of your President Year at the Annual Conference.
- o) Approve the NYSWi minutes of the Annual Conference which took place at the close of her term of office.
