Title: Historian

Description: The Historian is responsible for preparing and maintaining the current year's history of New York State Women, Inc. and selecting the Local Chapter's History Award winner.

Structure of Committee: The committee is composed of the Chair and a minimum of two members.

Duties of the State Chair

- 1) The appointment of the Historian, for the following year's history, is made by the President-Elect with the approval of the Executive Committee
- 2) Prepare the current year's history:
 - a) Keep an accurate record of notable events and achievements
 - b) Record state meeting events board meetings and annual conference
 - c) Prepare and present the document to the State President by the following year's Annual Conference
 - d) Distribute copies to the members who served on the Board of Directors during that year.
- 3) Distribute criteria for the Local Chapter History award
 - a) Notify the Local Chapters of the Local Chapter History Guidelines (TK 2.09)
 - b) With the Historian committee, select the winners and present the award at the Annual Conference

Duties of the Region Chair

- 1) The Region's Historian is appointed at the discretion of the Region Director
- 2) The Historian prepares the current year's history and presents the document to the Region Director at the conclusion of the year

Duties of the Chapter Chair

- 1) The Local Chapter's Historian is appointed by the Local Chapter President
- 2) The Historian prepares the current year's history; adds the material to previous year's history and presents the file/binder to the Local Chapter President at the conclusion of the year
