#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1) Entries for the Local Chapter History Award
  - a) should be submitted to the NYS Women, Inc History chair, see Leadership Directory for contact information in both hard copy and electronic form

# 2) Entry Format:

- a) The words "LOCAL CHAPTER HISTORY" must appear on the cover and in the subject line of the email
- b) Subsequent pages shall include the following **REQUIRED** information/format:
  - a. Number of members as of March 31 of the current year
  - b. Charter date
  - c. Local Chapters Historian contact information
  - d. Division of history into 5-year periods
- c) Suggested information for inclusion in the history:
  - a. Copy of charter
  - b. List of Local Chapters Presidents
  - c. Local, region and state functions
  - d. NIKE articles
  - e. Members who accepted leadership positions at local, region and state level
  - f. Awards
  - g. Programming
  - h. Fundraising
  - i. Celebrations

### 3) Deadline for all submissions:

a. Entry must be postmarked or emailed no later than May 1 of the current year.

## 4) Judging:

- a. is based on content (style, originality, neatness, substance), NYSW, Inc. focus, award submission instructions and required information. Suggested information will be used in a tiebreaking situation.
- b. Will be conducted by the NYSW, Inc. Historian committee prior to the Annual Conference. Non-NYSW, Inc. judges may be selected to enhance the judging process.

#### 5) Awards:

- a. The committee will determine how the entry will be recognized based on NYSW, Inc. finances. Minimum recognition will be a certificate of participation.
- b. All entries will be on display, if space is available, during the NYSW, Inc. Annual Conference. Arrangements for the entry to be picked up will be announced during the meeting.
